STUDENT FUND: There will be a second collection after masses at St. Ann's and St. Quivox today.

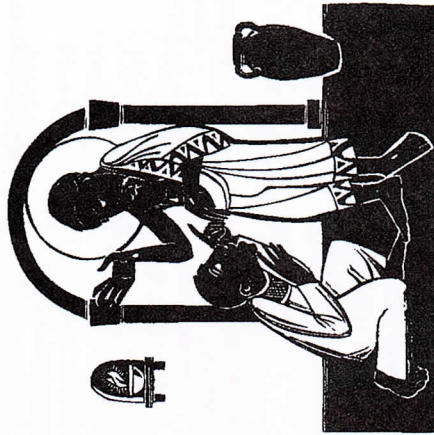
LEPRA: A representative from LEPRA will be making an appeal at all masses at St. Ann's and St. Quivox on Sunday 15th April.
