St Quivox Building Fund: We have identified four areas of the church that require urgent attention to keep the building wind and watertight. The second, a particularly invasive form of dry rot, is being worked on now, and will be followed in due course by the remaining two jobs, both back on the roof. The work is being conducted according to the level of urgency. A notice in the porch gives an idea of progress.
