Holy Week-part 1: The Prestwick churches are taking part in joint services during Holy Week in St. Ninian's Episcopal Church at 7:30 each evening from Monday 3rd April - Friday 7th April. St Quivox, along with Monkton and Prestwick North Church, are leading the service on the Monday evening and we have been asked to provide a reader and two "welcomers". If you can help, please let me know.

Holy Week-part 2: The mass of Chrism will be celebrated by Archbishop Nolan in St Margaret's cathedral, Ayr at 7.30pm on Tuesday 4th April. In St Quivox mass on Holy Thursday will be at 7pm with night prayer in the hall at 9pm. There is no mass on Good Friday, but the commemoration of the Passion will be at 3pm, with morning prayer at 10am on Holy Saturday and the Easter Vigil at 9pm. Mass on Easter Sunday will be at 9.45am as usual, but there will be no Evening mass on Easter Sunday.

There are still a few places for volunteers for the Holy Week services, **please sign up** if you can, so that our liturgies can be as good as we can make them.

Lenten Reflections: During the Sunday afternoons of lent Michael Pratchett is offering a series of reflections on Christ's Passion. For more details, please see the posters or speak to Michael.
