St Quivox Building Fund: Over the past few months several people have commented on damp patches staining the inside of the church, we also have a serious fungal infection in part of the church. These problems stem from issues with the roof, some of which require urgent attention. The work to the roof alone will cost several thousand pounds, and while we do have funds to cover the most urgent work, our savings were drawn upon significantly during Covid, to the point where we no longer have a comfortable reserve should any unexpected problems arise. From this weekend the collection boxes will be left out, on those weekends when there is no other statutory special collection, and labelled "building Fund" with any money donated being used for the repair and maintenance of St Quivox.
