**Ash Wednesday:** Ash Wednesday this year is on 14<sup>th</sup> February, with mass at 10am in St Quivox and 6.30pm in St Ann's.

**Saturday Mass:** Several of the teachers from our schools are making a pilgrimage around the deanery, starting with mass in one church the walking to one of the neighbouring parishes for a cup of tea. Next Saturday, 17<sup>th</sup> February, they will be starting from St Quivox with Mass at 10am, please come along and join us and give the walkers all the encouragement they need to walk from here to St Paul's in Ayr. You would also be welcome to walk with them and share the refreshments at St Paul's.

**Lent:** Next Sunday, 18<sup>th</sup> February, will be the first Sunday of Lent, when we will celebrate the Rite of Enrolment with the children making their first communion later this year. First Communion itself will be on Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> May.
