Responsorial Psalm: *Your ways, Lord, are faithfulness and love for those who keep your covenant.*

Mass this week: Mass this week will be at 10am on Monday and Thursday.

Lent: Today, Sunday 18th February, is the first Sunday of Lent, when we celebrate the Rite of Enrolment with the children making their first communion later this year. First Communion itself will be on Saturday 11th May. During Lent we are encouraged to support the work of **SCIAF**, both through their Wee Box campaign and the special collection taken up on the fourth Sunday of Lent.

Stations of the Cross: At 7pm on the Wednesdays of Lent there will be an opportunity to reflect on the Stations of the Cross in the church at St Quivox. There is a sheet for volunteers to lead these services.

Lenten Talks: There will be a series of reflections based on the commentary by Fr. Raymond E. Brown around the passion narrative of St. Matthew. These will be on Sunday 18th and 25th of February and Sunday 3rd and 17th March, all from 2.00 – 3.30pm. The sessions will take place in St. Quivox church hall.

Ordination Tickets: St Quivox has been allocated 11 tickets for Bishop Frank's ordination in Ardrossan on 9th March, and a further 11 for the mass at the Cathedral on Sunday 10th March.
