Holy Week: Palm Sunday marks the beginning of Holy Week. Each evening there will be services beginning at 7.30pm in St. Nicholas Church, to which everyone is invited, with New Life and St Quivox leading the service on Monday 25th March. The Mass of Chrism will be celebrated in St Margaret's Cathedral by Bishop Frank Dougan on Tuesday 26th March, again, all are welcome.

Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday will be at 7pm with night prayer in the hall at 9pm. As we did last year, those willing to have their feet washed are invited to sit at the end of a row and I will come to you.

Mass is not celebrated on Good Friday, but the commemoration of the Passion will be at 3pm and the Easter Vigil will be at 9pm on Saturday 30th March. All of which will be in St Quivox. Mass on Easter Sunday will be at 9.45am in St Quivox and 11.30 in St Ann's, Mossblown. There will be no evening Mass on Easter Sunday.
