Dates for your diaries: Ash Wednesday this year is on 14th February with the 18th being the first Sunday of Lent, when we will celebrate the Rite of Enrolment with the children making their first communion later this year. First Communion itself will be on Saturday 11th May.

A new bishop for Galloway: Fr Frank Dougan, from Motherwell, will become the next bishop of our Diocese of Galloway. His ordination is confirmed for 9th March in St Peter's, Ardrossan, with a service in St Margaret's the following day, where our new bishop will "take possession" of his church.
