**Mass this week:** Mass this week will be at 10am on Monday and Thursday.

**Confirmation:** Confirmation this year will be on Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> February in St Meddan's, Troon. Thanks to those who came along to the meeting on Monday evening.

**Dates for your diaries:** Ash Wednesday this year is on 14<sup>th</sup> February, with mass at 10am in St Quivox and 6.30pm in St Ann's. The 18<sup>th</sup> will be the first Sunday of Lent, when we will celebrate the Rite of Enrolment with the children making their first communion later this year. First Communion itself will be on Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> May.

**The Bishop's Ordination:** On the weekend of 9<sup>th</sup> -10<sup>th</sup> March there will be two celebrations associated with the Ordination of Frank Dougan. An allocation of tickets for each parish will be made known on Friday 16<sup>th</sup> February. The allocation is based on the number of people attending Sunday. Around 250 places are expected to be available at each venue for all parishes. The Ordination will be live streamed to the parish hall of St Peter-in-Chains and anyone who does not have a ticket will be welcome to attend in the hall until it is filled.
