Since I can neither turn water into wine nor multiply sausage rolls, if you are thinking of coming, ***please put your name on the list*** in the church porch. Links to the music that will be used are on our website and Facebook page so that you can hear the music in advance, which might help you join in with the singing if you are there.

**Thursday Mass:** Because of the thanksgiving mass in the evening, there will be no Thursday morning mass this week.

While we are excited about this and will remain St Ninian's primary, it is definitely the end of an era. I think it is worth emphasising that this isn't a crèche or child care facility, it is a liturgy of the word prepared for children of primary school age, it draws on the same passages of scripture we use in the church but presents them in a way that helps children understand them better.
