Anniversary: On 23rd June I will have been a priest for 25years, during which time there have been many challenges and even more blessings, but always supported by people in the parishes I have been fortunate enough to have been appointed to, the schools as well. I would like to mark the anniversary by giving thanks for the people who have accompanied me on that journey and the blessings they have brought. If anyone would like to join me, you would be most welcome at a mass of thanksgiving at 7pm on Thursday 23rd June in St Quivox followed by refreshments in the hall.
